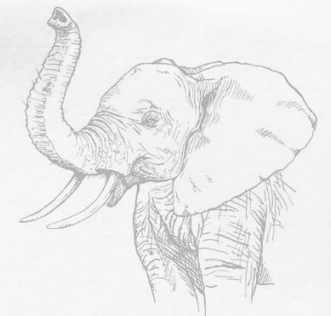

It's violence.

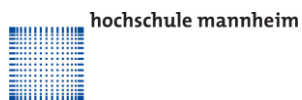
That's why we say «sexual violence».
